

## HSP90 $\alpha$ Assay Kit

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**Product Overview**

Hsp90 $\alpha$  is a molecular chaperone with essential functions in maintaining transformation. Inhibition of Hsp90 $\alpha$  function has been shown to play a role in tumorigenesis and disease progression.

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**Description**

The HSP90 $\alpha$  Assay Kit is designed for identification of HSP90 $\alpha$  inhibitors using fluorescence polarization. The assay is based on the competition of fluorescently labeled geldanamycin for binding to purified recombinant HSP90 $\alpha$ . The key to the HSP90 $\alpha$  Assay Kit is the fluorescently labeled geldanamycin. Using this kit, only one simple step on a microtiter plate is required for HSP90 $\alpha$  reactions. The fluorescently labeled geldanamycin is incubated with a sample containing HSP90 $\alpha$  enzyme to produce a change in fluorescent polarization that can then be measured using a fluorescence reader.

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**Applications**

Great for studying enzyme kinetics and screening small molecular inhibitors for drug discovery and HTS applications.

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**Storage**

Stable for at least 12 months from date of receipt, when stored as directed. Kit components require different storage conditions. Be sure to store each component at the proper temperature upon arrival.

Hsp90 $\alpha$  recombinant enzyme: 100  $\mu$ g; -80°C FITC-labeled geldanamycin (2.5  $\mu$ M): 30  $\mu$ l; -80°C 5x Hsp90 assay buffer: 4 ml; -20°C Black, low binding NUNC microtiter plate: 1; Room temp.
